Grammar Review

Review of past continuous tense: The past continuous tense is used to describe an action that was in
progress at a specific time in the past. It is formed with the auxiliary verb "was/were" + the present
participle of the main verb (e.g., "I was studying").

Review of past simple tense: The past simple tense is used to describe a completed action in the past. It is formed with the past form of the verb (e.g., "I studied").
