Introduction

This lesson plan is designed to help young adults aged 23 understand and apply the concepts of the phallic and latency stages, as outlined in psychoanalytic theory, to real-world scenarios and personal development plans. By exploring these stages, students will gain insight into their own psychological development and learn how to leverage this knowledge for personal growth and self-awareness.

Lesson Objectives

- Analyze the characteristics of the phallic and latency stages and their impact on psychological development
