Introduction

The simple present tense is a fundamental concept in English grammar that is essential for effective communication. In this worksheet, you will learn how to form and use the simple present tense correctly.

Formation of the Simple Present Tense

The simple present tense is formed using the base form of the verb, with the addition of -s or -es for the third person singular.

- I walk (first person singular)
- you walk (second person singular)
- he/she/it walks (third person singular)

There are some exceptions and irregularities in the simple present tense, such as verbs that do not add -s or -es in the third person singular.
