## Section 1: Multiple Choice (10 minutes)

2. Which of the following is a primary color?

## Section 2: Short Answer (10 minutes)

## Section 3: Project-Based (10 minutes)

- Overall artwork (2 points)
  - Creativity and originality (1 point)
  - Technical skill and execution (1 point)
