## 3. Virtuoso

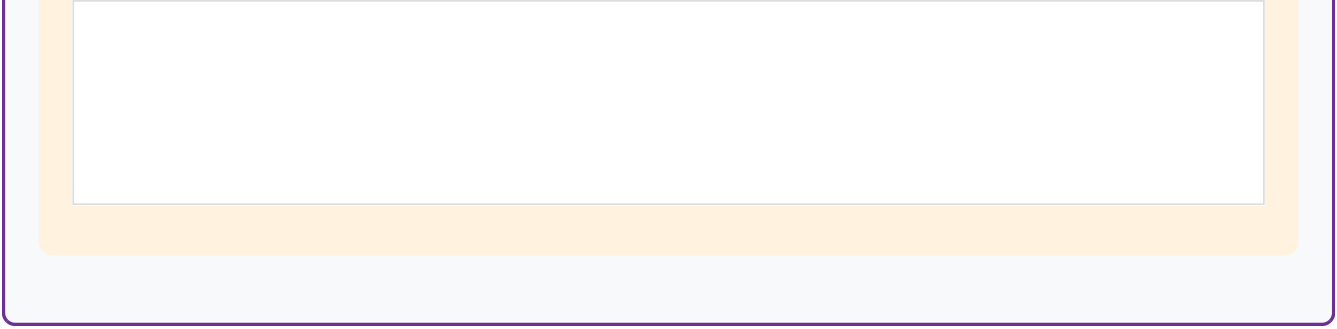
/ˌvɜːtʃuˈəʊsəʊ/
