2. Describe the role of women in Ancient Egyptian society. How did their roles and responsibilities impact daily life and cultural practices?

Primary Source Analysis (15 minutes)

What can we learn about Ancient Egyptian daily life from Ahmose's story?

Debate (20 minutes)
