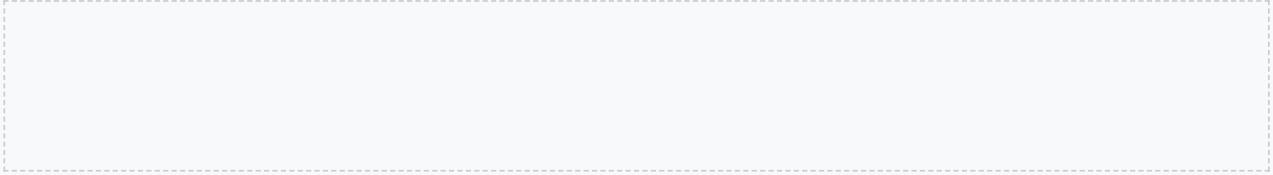
1. Greet your mom when she comes home from work.

*Draw a picture of yourself greeting a family member or friend. Write a short sentence about the greeting.*




