

Introduction

This worksheet is designed to help you understand and practice nouns and verbs. Nouns are words that refer to people, places, and things, while verbs are words that express actions or states of being.

Objective: By the end of this worksheet, you will be able to identify and use nouns and verbs correctly in sentences.

Noun Identification

Exercise: Identify the nouns in the following sentences:

1. The dog runs quickly. (Answer: dog)
2. The teacher writes on the board. (Answer: teacher, board)
3. The city is big and busy. (Answer: city)

Verb Identification

Exercise: Identify the verbs in the following sentences:

1. The dog runs quickly. (Answer: runs)
2. The teacher writes on the board. (Answer: writes)

- teacher

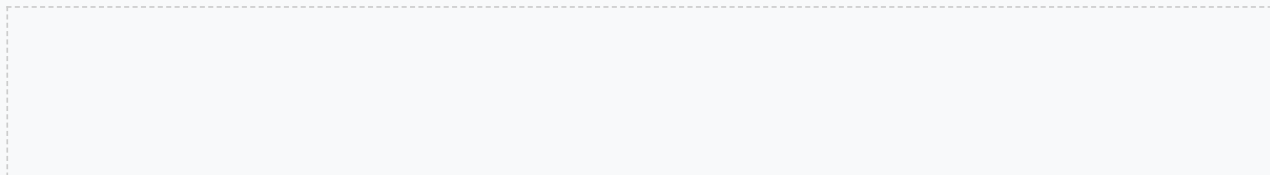
Verbs:
