1. What was the main idea of the podcast?
2. What were some key points or supporting details?
3. How did the speaker use language to engage the audience?

Activity 3: Role-Play

Participate in a role-play scenario, such as ordering food at a restaurant or making a reservation at a hotel. Practice using English language structures and vocabulary in context. Discuss the following questions:

1. What were some challenges you faced during the role-play?
2. How did you use language to communicate effectively?
3. What would you do differently next time?

Activity 4: Group Discussion

Participate in a group discussion on a topic of interest, such as social media or environmental issues. Practice using English language structures and vocabulary in context. Discuss the following questions:

1. What are some benefits and drawbacks of social media?
2. How does social media impact our daily lives?
3. What can we do to reduce our environmental footprint?

Activity 5: Presentation

Prepare a short presentation on a topic of interest. Practice using English language structures and vocabulary in context. Discuss the following questions:

1. What are some key points you want to include in your presentation?
2. How will you use language to engage your audience?
3. What are some potential questions or challenges you may face during the presentation?
