
## Instrument Fun

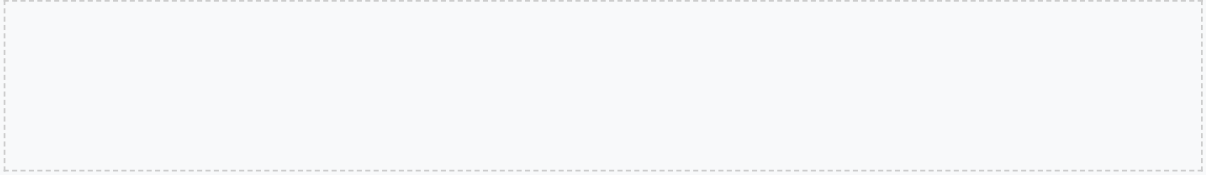


## Create Your Own Music


## Music Storytelling


