#### Short Answer Answers:

- 1. A player would use a "dribble" to move the ball when they are trying to get past an opponent.
- 2. A "tackle" is when a player tries to win the ball from an opponent, while a "block" is when a player tries to stop an opponent from moving forward.
- 3. A team would use a "corner kick" to score a goal when they are trying to score from a corner of the field.
- 4. A player who plays in the defense and helps the goalkeeper is called a "defender".
- 5. A player would use a "pass" to move the ball to a teammate when they are trying to create a scoring opportunity.
