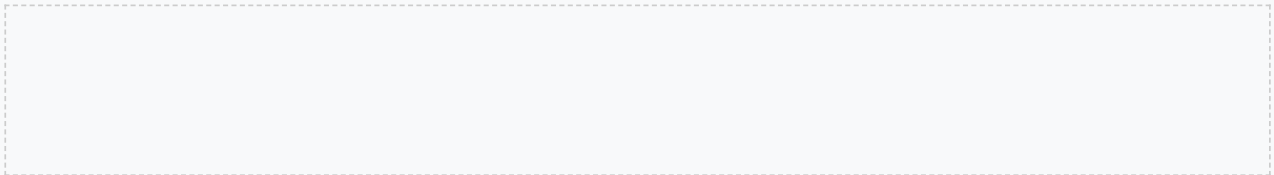




Introduction

For Advanced Learners!

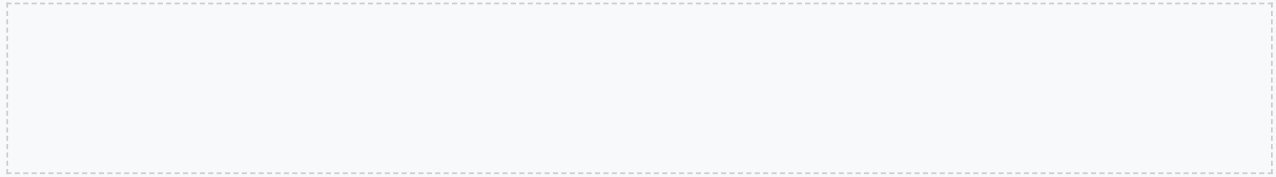
We will complete the following extension tasks:
