Introduction


Nouns and verbs are the building blocks of language. In this worksheet, we will explore the definitions, roles, and applications of nouns and verbs in sentences.

Noun Identification

- The city is beautiful. (Answer: city)




Visual Aid: Diagram showing the nouns in each sentence

- The city is beautiful. (Answer: is)




Visual Aid: Diagram showing the verbs in each sentence


Exercise: Complete the following sentences with the correct noun or verb:

Passage: The teacher writes on the board. The students read their books.

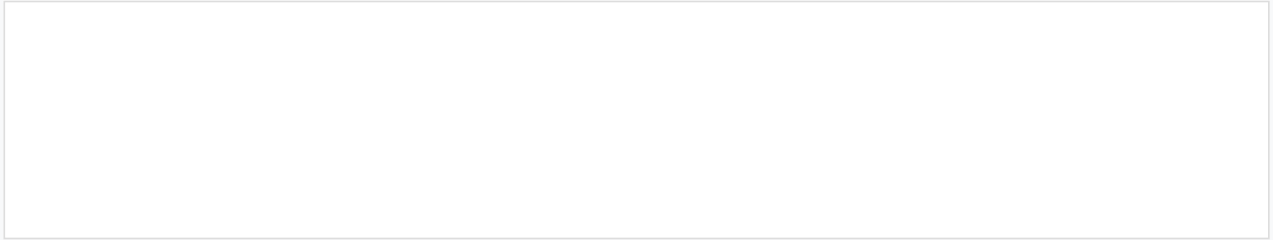
Answer: Nouns: teacher, board, students, books; Verbs: writes, read
