



## Introduction (5 minutes)


1. Open the digital painting software and create a new document.



*Create a simple digital landscape using the basic painting tools. Include a sky, mountains, and trees.*

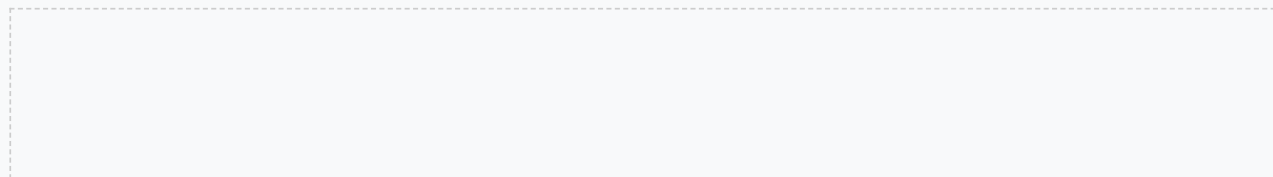
1. What brush did you use to paint the sky?

Create a color harmony exercise using the digital painting software. Select a color and create a harmonious color scheme.

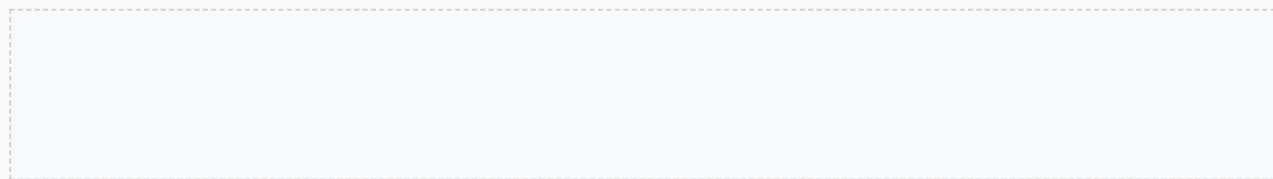
1. What is color harmony?
