Introduction to French Adjectives

Welcome to the world of French adjectives! Adjective Agreements in French

In French, adjectives must agree with the nouns they modify in gender and number. This means that the adjective changes its form to match the gender and number of the noun.

- Masculine singular: le grand homme (the big man)
- Feminine singular: la grande femme (the big woman)
- Masculine plural: les grands hommes (the big men)
- Feminine plural: les grandes femmes (the big women)

Examples of Adjective Agreements

- Le petit garçon (the small boy)
- La petite fille (the small girl)
- Les petits garçons (the small boys)
- Les petites filles (the small girls)
