



Introduction to the Past Simple Tense

The past simple tense is used to describe actions that happened at a specific time in the past. It is formed by adding -ed to the base form of regular verbs, while irregular verbs have their own unique past simple forms.

Examples of regular verbs in the past simple tense include:

- walk - walked
- play - played
- eat - ate

Examples of irregular verbs in the past simple tense include:

- go - went
- take - took
- see - saw

Using the Past Simple Tense in Sentences

- My family went to the beach last summer.
- I ate breakfast at 7:00 AM.

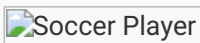
Timeline Activity
