Short Answer Questions

- 1. Urban settlements have a higher population density and focus on industries and services, while rural settlements have a lower population density and focus on agriculture.
- 2. Advantages: low cost of living, easy access to education and healthcare, and a wider range of job opportunities. Disadvantages: high crime rates, traffic congestion, and high cost of living.

Essay Question

- The role of urban settlements in the economy: Urban settlements contribute to the country's GDP through job creation in industries and services. They are also centers of trade and commerce.

- For learners who struggle: Provide visual aids, such as pictures or videos, to illustrate urban settlements. Allow learners to work in groups to help each other.
